



## **Fastest Growing Jobs**

On this Labor Day, as many continue to look for work, there's a new list of the fastest growing jobs in United States.

According to Fortune, nursing tops the list, followed by network systems and data analysts, software engineers, biomedical engineers, accountants and auditors, and finally veterinarians.

Analysts say as baby boomers age and demand for health care services surge, the number of registered nurses is expected to grow to 3.2 million by 2018, accounting for more than 581,000 new jobs, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. That represents the largest overall growth projection out of all occupations in the U.S. economy.

"There's always going to be a need for health care," said RN Steven Hernandez, who works for JFK Memorial Hospital in Indio, the very place where he was born.

"I feel like I'm giving a little something back."

Hernandez, who's been an RN for about a year says the job is giving him stability.

"You have that sense of security," he said.

Along with registered nurses, home care aids, physicians assistants, pharmacists and other medical professions will be in high demand, according to Sageworks, a financial analysis company.
